



ADVANTAGES OF COURT-LED MEDIATION

WHAT IS COURT-LED MEDIATION?


Mediator



Court-led mediation is a dispute resolution system in which civil dispute can be settled, with the facilitation of a mediator through an agreement between the Parties that they can accept.




VOLUNTARY MEDIATION



Mediation can be conducted mainly according to the wishes of the Parties.
