



Issuance of the Union Supreme Court: the Key Performance in 2021 and Priority Actions for 2022

Nay Pyi Taw, 17 February 2022- The Supreme Court of the Union today issues the key performance in 2021 and priority actions for 2022.

The Key Performance in 2021

- ❖ Improving clearance rate of cases at the different levels of court up to 114 %
- ❖ Expanding the implementation of National Case Management program (NCMP) in 22 district courts and 83 township courts.
- ❖ Implementing the Court-led Mediation Pilot Program in all courts of Mandalay Region and Yangon Region.
- ❖ Introducing the Commercial Judgment System (CJS)
- ❖ Supporting the enactment of the Law Amending the Civil Procedure Code for Mediation
- ❖ Issuing the Method of Operation of the Video or Live Television Link System for taking Evidence

Priority Actions for 2022

- ❖ Complete the implementation of National Case Management Program (NCMP) in 10 district courts and 58 township courts
- ❖ Expand nationwide the Court-led Mediation Program
- ❖ Establish electronic library system at the Supreme Court of the Union
- ❖ Develop database system for digitized case files and documents at the Supreme Court of the Union
